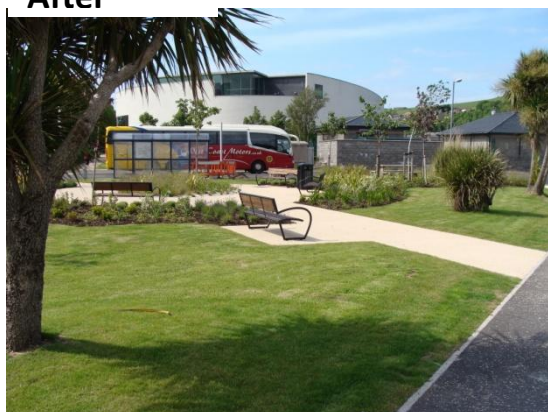

Project Outline

McFadyens Contractors worked as the principal contractor on this project for all civil engineering and landscaping works for this aspect of the CHORD regeneration scheme. Works commenced in the second quarter of 2013 and were completed in June 2013 taking under 2 months to complete in accordance with the project plan.

The project involved both hard and soft landscaping improvements and re-design to this prominent and well used public space; with footway re-alignment, widening and replacement construction, including supply and installation of conservation kerbs and importing all infill material.

Extensive soft landscaping works were undertaken with turf removal, topsoiling and re-turfing. Supply and planting of 1,700 plants consisting of perennials, shrubs and feature plants, tree anchoring and irrigation systems. Planting beds were finished with decorative bark and crushed cockleshell mulch.

We supplied and laid 200sqm of the Rocbinda resin bonded aggregate system, as an accredited contractor, to provide the decorative anti-slip footway finish together with the installation of the new street and park furniture.

The project was delivered successfully to project plan timescales.
